APA: In-text Citation & References Page

Parenthetical (In-Text) Citation:

will appear at the **END** of your sentence **AFTER** the information you **QUOTED** or **PARAPHRASED** from your source.

Two Important Parts:

The **SOURCE'S LAST NAME** followed by the **PUBLICATION YEAR** and **PAGE NUMBER** of where you cited your information.

Example:

Your passage will be located here, when you “quote an author, you will have the in-text citation at the end with”
(Author's Last Name, Year, pg#).
***DO NOT FORGET** to place **COMMAS** in this information*

Example:

Children and adults see the world differently, which can make their parent' divorce especially unsettling
(Neuman, 1998, p. 43).

The author states in his article, “Africa's other problems is one of the most significant is the lack of electricity” (Friedman, 2008, p. 155).

Citing Books & Other Sources:

Book Citations will have the following

Author. (Year of Publication). *Title of Work.* City and State (or Country) of publication: Publisher.

Examples:

Book with One Author

Jones, S. (2011). *Darwin's ghost: The origin of species updated.* New York, NY: Ballantine.

Book with a Corporate/Organization Author

American Psychiatric Association. (1994). *Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders.* (4th ed.). Washington, DC: **Author.**

Academic Journals Citations will have the following:

Author. (Date of Publication). *Title of article.* *Title of Journal,* **volume number** (issue number), **page numbers.**

Electronic Sources:

Website with Author

Author of Website. (Date Published). *Title of Page.* *Title of Overall Website.* Retrieved: URL info.

Website with Corporate/No Author

Corporate Author. (Date Published). *Title of Page.* Retrieved from: URL info

If no 'Date of Publication' Format:

(n.d.)
