### AGENDA ITEM II – Approval of Minutes

Teri Garcia made motion to approve the March 27, 2018 Board Regular meeting minutes as presented, April 10, 2018 Board Retreat meeting minutes as presented, May 8, 2018 Board Special meeting minutes as presented and May 22, 2018 Board Special meeting minutes as presented Gerald O'Hara seconded. They were listening and they were interested in our issues. Dr. Malm did a great job with his presentation. The Regents were very open to having open communications with the Local Board. The Local Board feels that it was a very good meeting and they are on the same page with the Regents.

### AGENDA ITEM IV – Chief Executive Officer's Report – James Malm

- 1. Strategic Enrollment Planning In-House FY2018-19 The Updated Strategic Enrollment Planning was presented to the Board. The Board was very receptive to this program.
- 2. Environmental Scanning Sr. Institutional Researcher Brittany Babycos reported an overview on the mission of the project which will collect financial, sociological, demographic, economical and technical data. There are about 30 faculty and staff who have volunteered to help in interviewing and gathering data. Training will begin later this week. Publication of the results is anticipated the end of August.
- 3. Enrollment Funnel with Multiple Entry Channels: External Consultants FY2018-19, 2019-20 Director of Student Affairs Jayme McMahon presented to the Board marketing and recruitment for student enrollment. Recruitment has been identified as a priority.
- 4. Dean of Instruction and Chair of Business and Applied Technology Search Interim Dean of Instruction and Search Committee Chair Irene Den Bleyker reported the search committees are moving forward. Candidates have been selected and are completing reference checks. Hopefully interviews will take place in July and chosen candidates who will begin work in August.

5. Monthly Consolidated Financial Reports through May 31, 2018 – Director of Business Operations Robert Griego submitted and reviewed the monthly reports.

## CEO Weekly Brief - 8/17/2018 Dr. James Malm SPECIAL EDITION

Many thanks to all who have participated in the Development Week activities. This has been a whirlwind week full of much energy and enthusiasm for our new fall semester. I wish all our faculty, staff and students a very successful semester full of learning, advancement and collaboration.

I would like to take this opportunity and this special edition of the Weekly Brief to introduce two new members of the UNM-Gallup community and welcome them to our campus.



### Dr. Daniel Primozic, Dean of Instruction

After a national search, UNM-Gallup is proud to introduce Dr. Daniel Primozic as the new dean of instruction. Dr. Primozic was most recently the director of curriculum and ethics for the FBI-Law Enforcement Development Association which is a position he held since January 2017. Prior to that, he occupied the positions of curriculum manager for the same Association and interim and associate director for the Institute for Law Enforcement Administration and the Center for Law Enforcement Ethics at the Center for American and International Law. From 2003 – 2007, Dr. Primozic served in a variety of administrative roles at Santa Fe Community College including assistant dean of academic affairs, acting vice president of academic and student affairs, dean of arts and sciences and dean of the liberal and fine arts. Dr. Primozic received a Ph.D. in Philosophy from the University of New Mexico in 1986, and a Master of Arts and a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy from Southern Illinois University.

Dr. Primozic is very excited to join UNM-Gallup and in a recent phone conversation noted, "As a first generation college student, I had my start at a community college in Chicago, which was a beginning I couldn't have afforded anywhere else. Community colleges are my first love and I want to give back to a place where students can get a good start."

Asked about his initial plans as dean of instruction, Dr. Primozic stated he wants to take some time to get to know the area and the campus. "Reading about a place is OK, but people are the institution. I'll be spending some time wandering around and getting to know people. I want them to know they can approach me. Getting to know the campus and the job will be very exciting for me."

He states that he sees his job as the dean of instruction as one that allows him to make it possible for everyone to benefit from their interactions with UNM-Gallup. "I like the parallels between this job and the positions I held at Santa Fe Community College. We can make it possible for people to learn and to become better students, faculty and staff. That's what this job is all about and I like that."

Dr. Primozac's first day at UNM-Gallup will be Monday, August 27.



### Mr. Mark Remillard, Chair, Business and Applied Technology, Community Education and Workforce Development

Mr. Remillard began his work as the chair of business and applied technology and community education and workforce development this past Monday, August 13. Prior to that, he had been the assistant principal at Lincoln Elementary and Roosevelt Elementary Schools in Gallup. He also served as an assistant principal at Gallup High School and an English teacher and librarian at Navajo Pine High School. Between 1996 and 2013, he served as a teacher and dean at several middle and high schools in Las Vegas, Nevada. Mr. Remillard is currently working on his dissertation to complete requirements for an Ed.D. in educational leadership from New Mexico State University. He also earned a Master of Arts in educational administration, and a Master of Arts in curriculum and instruction from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, a Master of Arts in theology from the The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. and a Bachelor of Arts in humanities from St. Joseph's College in Mountain View, California.

Mr. Remillard feels very good about his first week on the job. "The first week went well. I found everyone to be friendly, welcoming and helpful. I appreciate the smooth transition." He recognizes and welcomes the diversity of his large division. "It is a good that we appeal to a lot of different students. Everything from adult education to our career oriented coursework is established to support families and the future careers of our students. We build bridges through job training and community services and in so doing, promote the face of UNM-Gallup."

He believes it is the job of the chair to see the strong connection between the work of the division and successful student numbers. "We have to decide which programs and career opportunities will allow graduates to get jobs and give back to the community and connect that to increased enrollments."

Mr. Remillard noted that he is a fan of education that prepares people to be competitive in their careers. "I am big on career and technical education and using applied tech to hook students and get them into programs. We need to work with feeder schools to do recruiting and program promotion to get students to come be a part of UNM-Gallup."

"This job is a passion for me. I am excited to be part of UNM-Gallup and contribute in a positive way. I plan on learning from everyone – students, staff, faculty and administrators."

### OPEN MEETINGS RESOLUTION OF THE UNM - GALLUP LOCAL BOARD

WHEREAS, the UNM Gallup Local Board is a duly constituted policy making body in accordance with NMSA 1978, Section 10-15-1 through 10-15-4, inclusive, as amended and supplemented; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 10-15-1.C provides that certain public meetings of certain public policy making bodies shall be held only after reasonable notice to the public and that the public policy making body shall determine at least annually in a public meeting what notice for a public meeting is reasonable; and

**WHEREAS**, the intention of the Resolution is to determine what notice of a public meeting shall be reasonable when applied to meetings of the Board as required by Section 10-15-1.C NMSA 1978; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the meeting of the UNM Gallup Local Board on August 28, 2018 has been given by publication in the Gallup Independent at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the time of the public meeting at which this Resolution is to be adopted.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the UNM Gallup Local Board that:

- 1. Reasonable notice was given to the public of the Board Meeting held August 28, 2018.
- 2. Reasonable notice to the public of any meetings of the Board or any meetings of a committee constituting a quorum of the Board shall consist of:
  - A. As to regular meetings of the Board, this notice shall be published annually listing the dates, time and location of monthly meetings. Monthly meeting agendas shall be given to the news media in the College District for publication at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance of the meeting. A list of the agenda items shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the UNM Gallup Administrative Office no later than seventy-two (72) hours before the regular meeting.
  - B. Unless otherwise indicated, meetings of the UNM Gallup Local Board shall be held at 1:00 p.m. on the following dates and location of: UNM Gallup Campus, Executive Conference Room GH1216, 705 Gurley Ave., Gallup, NM.

- C. As to special meetings of the Board, which may be called at any time by the Chair of the Board or by written request of three members, therefore, notice of the date, time and place of special meetings of the Board shall be given to the news media for publication at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance of the meeting. A list of the agenda items shall also be given.
- D. As to the emergency meetings of the Board, notice of the date, time and place of emergency meetings shall be given to the news media for publication at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the meeting, unless threat of personal injury or property damage requires less notice. The general subject matter of the meeting shall also be given.

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E. Additional notices: notice of special and emergency meetings shall also be posted in a conspicuous place in the UNM Gallup Administration Office at the same time notice is given to the news media.

Notice of the information meetings shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the UNM Gallup Administration Office at the same time Board members are informed of such meetings. Notices will be sent to all federally licensed broadcast stations and newspapers of general circulation in McKinley County that request in writing to receive copies of Board meeting notices.

The Board shall review these notice requirements annually at the regular September meeting and determine whether any amendments are warranted.

As used in the resolution, news media shall mean the *Gallup Independent* or any newspaper of general circulation throughout McKinley County, or any radio or television station which regularly broadcasts news throughout McKinley County. Notice shall mean notice in person, by telephone or written notice to the general manager or other radio or television station employee generally responsible for accepting public service announcements or to the news clerk of any newspaper of general circulation throughout McKinley County.

- 3. The foregoing determination shall be applicable to the Board Meeting held on this 28h day of August, 2018, and all meetings held after August 28, 2018 until August, 2019.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 10-15-1(C) of the Open Meetings Act, any member of the UNM Gallup Local Board may participate in a meeting of the Local Board of the Gallup Campus, by means of a conference telephone or other similar communications equipment when it is otherwise difficult or impossible for the members to attend the meeting in person, provided that each member participating by conference telephone can be identified when speaking, all participants are able to hear each other at the same time, and members of the public attending the meeting are able to hear any member of the Local Board of the Gallup Campus who speaks during the meeting.
- 5. In addition to the information specified above, all notices shall include the following language: If you are an individual with a disability who is in need of a reader, amplifier, qualified sign language interpreter, or any other form of auxiliary aid or service to attend or participate in the meeting, please contact the Chief Executive Officer's Office (505) 863-7501 at least one week prior to the meeting or as soon as possible. Public documents, including the agenda and minutes, can be provided in various accessible formats. Please contact the Chief Executive Officer's Office if a summary or other type of accessible format is needed.
- The UNM Gallup Local Board may close a meeting to the public only if the subject matter of such discussion or action is exempted from the open meeting requirement under Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings Act.
  - A. If any meeting is closed during an open meeting, such closure shall be approved by a majority vote of the quorum of the UNM Gallup Local Board taken during the open meeting. The authority for the closure and the subjects to be discussed shall be stated in the motion for closure and the vote on closure of each individual member shall be recorded in the minutes. Only those subjects specified in the motion may be discussed in a closed meeting; and
  - B. If the decision to hold a closed meeting is made when the UNM Local Board is not in open meeting, the closed meeting shall not be held until public notice, appropriate under the circumstances and stating the specific provision of law authorizing the closed meeting and the subjects to be discussed, is given to the members and to the general public; and

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C. Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(E), any action taken as a result of discussion in a closed meeting shall be made by vote of the UNM Gallup Local Board in an open public meeting.
