Report to the Dean & Faculty Assembly: Associate of Arts & Certificate, Human Services

The University of New Mexico – Gallup's Associate of Arts degree program in Human Services and Certificate program in Human Services were recently reviewed at the 17 November 2017 meeting of the Faculty Assembly Curriculum Committee. In a unanimous decision, and after carefully examining the material submitted by the Division of Education, Health, and Human Services, the Committee decided to accept the AA in Human Services program review and the Certificate in Human Services program review in their entirety.

Both program reviews were well-written, included all required materials, and made exceptional use of what little data was available. The committee suggests maintaining and expanding current articulation agreements with four-year institutions, and it also recommends lowering the required number of credit hours in the Human Services AA to 60 (an effort that has already been clearly considered by the Human Services faculty). Otherwise, we are confident that these programs will continue to benefit and serve students well into our institution's future.
