<u>Report to the Dean and the Faculty Assembly: Certificate in Nursing</u> <u>Assistant</u>

The University of New Mexico-Gallup's Certificate in Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program was reviewed at the March 26, 2021 meeting of the Faculty Assembly Curricula Committee. In a unanimous decision (with one abstention by Jonathan Lumibao, program director and author of the CNA program review) and after carefully reviewing the documentation submitted by the Division of Education, Health, and Human Services, **the committee voted to approve the CNA Program Review.** While impressed with the overall quality of the program review in terms of its clarity, content, and organization, the committee noted that additional data regarding student retention and transfer rates would be useful in future program reviews, as would more clearly articulated program goals and assessment measures.

This program review was well-written and complete. The committee is confident that the CNA program will continue to flourish and benefit area students well into our institution's future.
