Report to the Dean and the Faculty Assembly: AA in Liberal Arts

The University of New Mexico-Gallup's AA program in Liberal Arts was reviewed at the September 20, 2019 meeting of the Faculty Assembly Curricula Committee. In a unanimous decision, and after carefully reviewing the documentation submitted by the Division of Fine Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences, **the committee opted to conditionally approve the AA in Liberal Arts Program Review.** While exceedingly impressed with the overall quality of the program review, the committee requested additional materials from the Division Chair, including: a summary of the program's outreach activities, the most recent CARC report, sample student assignments, adjunct faculty CV information, and a statement on future plans for resource allocation. An addendum containing the requested materials was submitted by the Division Chair in January 2020.

This program review was well-written and complete. The committee believes it might serve as an exemplary model for other programs to follow, particularly in its formatting of side-by-side comparisons with other regional programs. The committee is confident that the already robust AA in Liberal Arts program will continue to grow and benefit area students well into our institution's future.
