

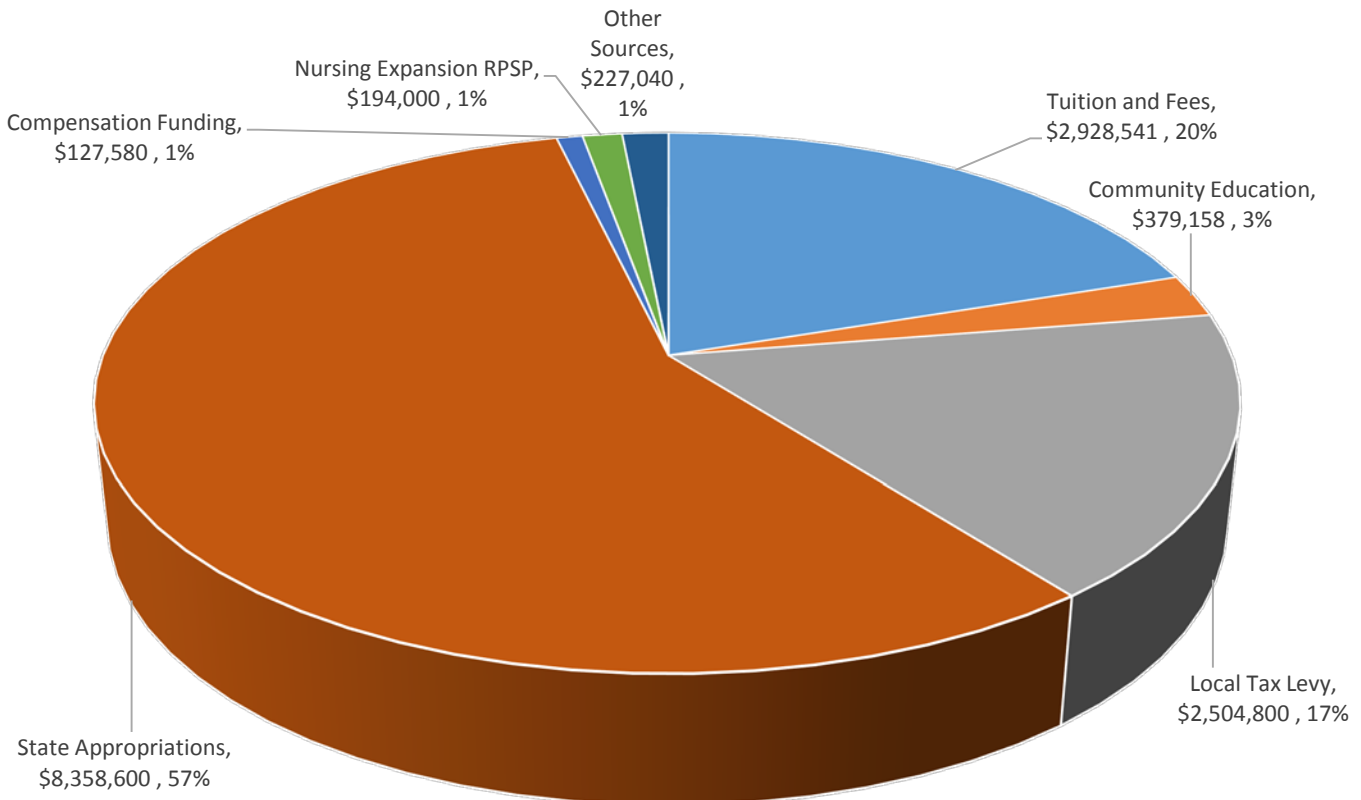

UNM-Gallup was established as a branch campus of the University of New Mexico in 1968 with 128 students in the Gallup High School Building.

Today, we have a diverse minority/majority student population of 2,079 (Spring 2019), of which 81% identify as multi-ethnic or a racial minority and 69% are Native American. Students learn on a sprawling campus with 10 buildings.
