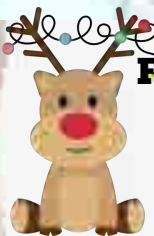
Beginning October 1st - December 12th

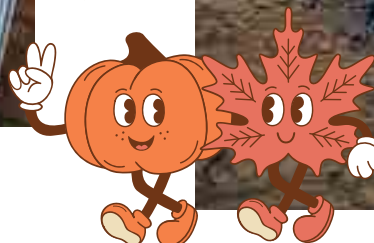
