#### Do you have any student habits you would recommend to other students? What are they?


The student habits that I would recommend is to study hard and finish your homework on time and always ask your professor for extra credit.

Dia de los Muertos, also known as the Day of the Dead, is a tradition that is celebrated in Hispanic culture.

During this day, families will celebrate the lives of their loved ones that have passed. They do this by preparing an ofrenda (an alter) with pictures of their loved ones and include items they enjoyed during their lifetime or items that their families remember them by.

It is also apart of tradition to leave a trail of marigold flower petals to help guide their passed loved ones home. Families will also remember the life of their passed loved ones on this day and celebrate with many festivities that include food, drinks, music and dancing.

It is believed that death is apart of one's journey and that it is not the end. So, this day is a celebration of life rather than death.
