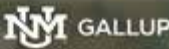

- Have completed at least 1 semester of college.
- Have a college GPA (no minimum required)

- Unofficial College Transcript
- Scholarship Resume (Not Employment Resume)
*Include Extracurricular Activities/ Honors/ Awards/ Co-curricular/ Volunteer Involvement. (Be specific, include dates and details of involvement.)

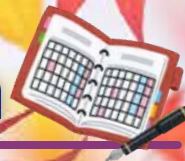
